## Youth Minister's Blog: A Light to the World (Steubenville Youth Conference Reflection)

Our world, most of the time, can be a doom and gloom place. Even within the Catholic Church we have crazy statistics that make the future look bleak at best. We've all heard the statistic that says only about 30% of Catholics believe in the true presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, but did you know that 80% of people who were raised Catholic end up leaving the Church before they reach their 20's (Note: This is a stat based on Americans).

I'm not sharing this with you so we can sit in the bad news but I wanted to contrast it with the good news, with one beautiful statistic of the Steubenville Youth Conference we attended this past weekend! A statistic that should bring light to the world.

2000. 2000 young people from across America and Canada gathered on the campus of [Franciscan University of Steubenville](#) to dive deeper into their faith through fellowship, prayer and the frequenting of the sacraments! By frequent, I mean FREQUENT. We were blessed enough to have Mass and Confession available to us every single day. Here is where I will insert an immense thank you to all the priests who showed up and heard HOURS of confessions during the conference. The biggest thank you to Fr. Michael who took the time to be with the youth of our parish, from apologetics on the (very long) bus ride, to just being there for the teens! We appreciate you and everything you do!

Each year the conference has a theme, this year the theme was "Illuminate" which comes from the bible verse John 1:5 which says *"The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not overcome it."* I thought that was a perfect theme and it encapsulates why I love my job so much. As youth ministers and youth ministry volunteers, we have the special privilege of getting to accompany young people in their faith journey at such a pivotal moment in their life. In the darkness of the world, we get to see teens pursue a real relationship with the Lord, we get to see the resilience of youth standing up for their faith in a world that rejects it, we get to see youth praising the Lord with everything they are. In the darkness of the world we see their light shining, and it is definitely a force to be reckoned with. The youth, at the conference, in this country, in this diocese, in our parish are lights that shine in the darkness. So, take heart in knowing that the young Church is very much alive and well!

Despite the long travel days, the missing hours of sleep and the little sniffles we have come back with, the Steubenville Youth Conference was a huge success and I would do it all over again for more teens to experience this (we can make that happen in summer 2025... stay tuned)!
