For this week's blog, I wanted to particularly share my views from the pews and some of the reflections that have come about in light of seeing families present at Mass. We are so blessed to have many young families attend our Sunday Masses (and even our daily Masses!) If you are a parent of young children reading this, thank you for bringing your kids to church! Whether you are in the family room, in the pews, or in the narthex rocking your baby, know that the Lord sees you and delights in the very fact that you are here. It truly is a gift to see your families especially your children, even in their shining, fussy, loud moments. When I see parents tending to their fussy children with so much patience and love, while also participating in the Mass, I am in awe of the juggle that this must be! Though this may be stressful, your very prayer and offering becomes the heroic love and patience you show your children. On the other hand, some times my views from the pews are infants resting in the arms of their parents.
