The Burning Flame: Symbolizes the intense, inextinguishable love Mary has for God and all of humanity.
The Piercing Sword: Represents Mary's sorrows and grief, specifically the prophecy of Simeon at the presentation of Jesus that a sword would pierce her soul, foreshadowing her pain at the Crucifixion.
The Roses: These flowers—often white or a wreath wrapping the heart—symbolize her immaculate purity, grace, and heavenly virtues.
The Heart Itself: It is shown outside of her body, indicating an overflowing love that cannot be contained.
