Brainstorm as a family a way you can show love to a friend or family member that will introduce them to Jesus.



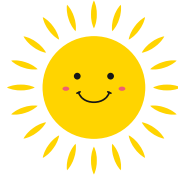
YOU DID IT!

5. What can you use to tell others about Jesus this week?

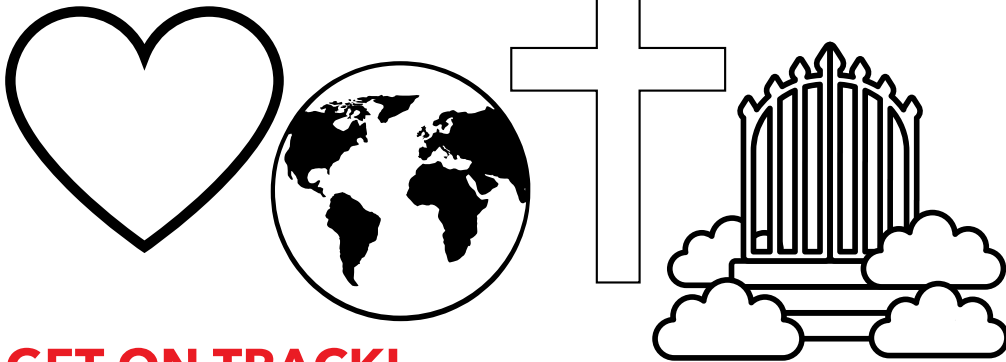

THINK RIGHT John 3:16 (Top 12)

"For God (point up) **so loved** (hands over heart) **the world** (hands circled above head) **that He gave His one** (pointer finger) **and only Son** (point to the palm of each hand), **that whoever believes** (point to head) **in Him** (point up) **shall not perish** (shake finger and head) **but have eternal life** (thumbs up)." **John 3:16**

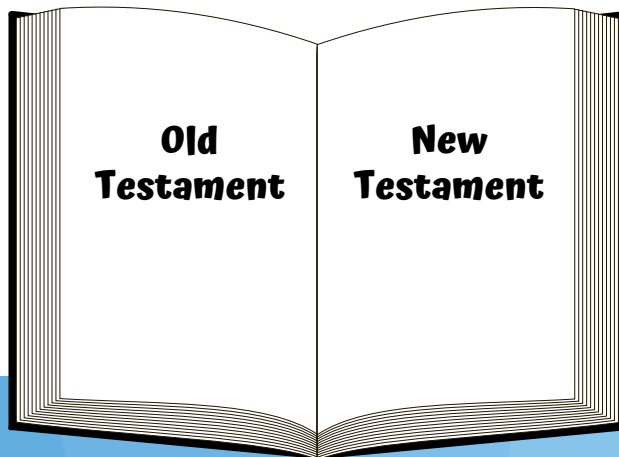
Color the pictures to help you learn John 3:16.

How can your preschooler be God's helper this week?

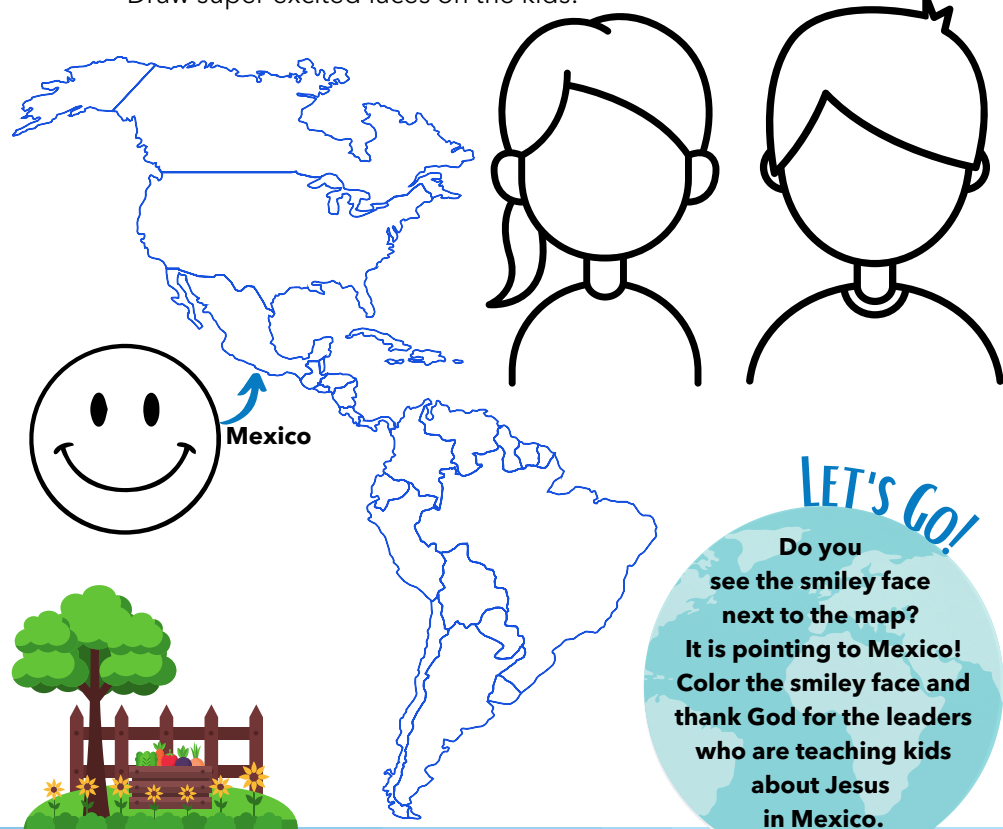
- Help pick up their toys.
