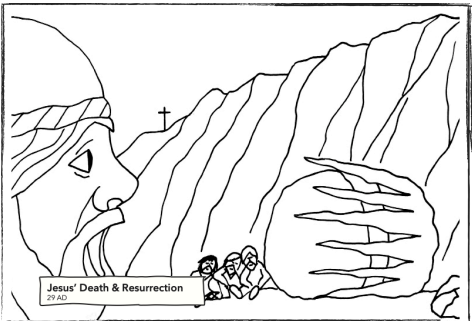
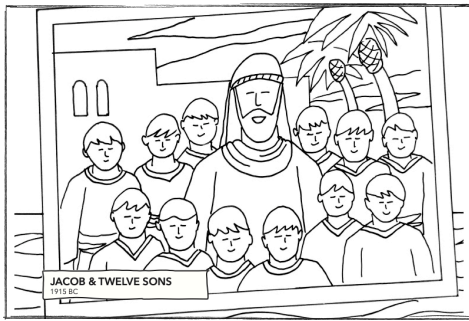


The Bible Timeline

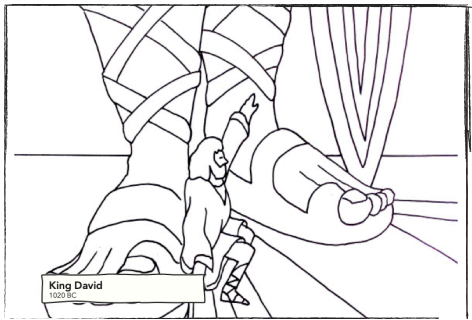

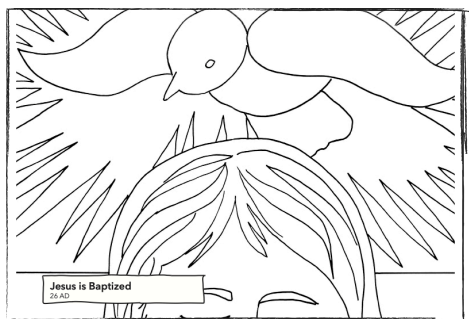
A. Luke 22-24
