Every good thing we have comes from God and belongs to Him.

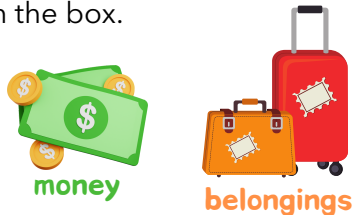


"The earth is the Lord's, and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it..." Psalm 24:1

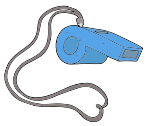

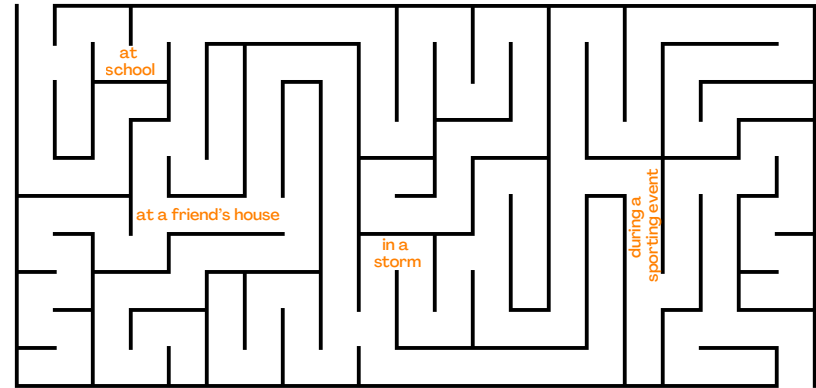
