## WHAT IS DIFFERENT THIS YEAR?

This year, our Middle School Ministry is partnering with **Fuge Camps**, for our week of student camp. Fuge Camps is an organization that has been planning + running camps for students since 1979. Partnering with Fuge allows our student team to focus more on **building relationships** with our students during the week of camp, rather than making sure the activities + schedules are running smoothly, as the Fuge workers will be handling all the recreation + service content this year!

Your student should be prepared to have **a ton of fun in activities**, not just our students, but other Student Ministries as well, and have **great conversations about their Next Steps** in their relationship with Christ.

A normal day at Fuge consists of recreation, worship, + afternoon tracks where your student can choose from a variety of options; from sports or learning musical instruments to deeper times of Bible study and training in spiritual disciplines. Having the Fuge staff to help us run these afternoon tracks allows our students to have a wider range of activities at camp than our team alone can provide, which has us extra excited about this partnership!

## WHO IS MIDDLE SCHOOL CAMP FOR?

Middle School Camp this year is for students who have **just completed 6th through 8th grade**. Our students will not be moving up to their new grades until the **Fall** when school kicks off.
