Any funds beyond that goal will be used for ministry during that trip, almost certainly in some ways that we know about (like groceries and water filtration units for needy families), as well as some ways that are yet to be determined. We are in conversation with our partners in Honduras about how those funds will be deployed, and we will give a full accounting of how God's providence will be used once a plan is developed.
