- Key of David The One Who Opens God's Kingdom to All
- Desire of Nations The One Who Saves All People
- Prince of Peace The One Whose Death and Life Bring Peace

In the New Testament, every Old Testament presentation and anticipation is gathered into one name—

## JESUS

For God was pleased to have all his fullness dwell in [Jesus], and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether things on earth or things in heaven, by making peace through his blood, shed on the cross.
