- **Read John 14:25-27**

4 *What are some ways that the Holy Spirit helps us as we are doing the work of a Christian?*

- **Read 1 Corinthians 6:19**

5 *What does it mean to you that the Holy Spirit actually lives in you?*

#### *The Power of Impossible to Possible*

- **Read Romans 8:11, Ephesians 1:20**

6 *Can you imagine the power it would take to raise someone from the dead?*

7 *Why do you think we as Christians sometimes question the Holy Spirit's power?*

8 *How can we grow in our relationship with God to tap the unlimited power of the Holy Spirit?*

- **Read 2 Corinthians 2:2-5**

9 *What was Paul relying on when he taught the Corinthians?*

10 *Why did he not try to show off his Bible knowledge?*

- **Read Luke 4:1-2, 14-15, reread or review Acts 1:4-11, Acts 4:1-22**

11 *Jesus called "common people" to be his disciples. How does this fact encourage you as you step out in faith using the Holy Spirit's power?*
