Connection groups will help us become a church whose people know each other, pray for each other, and walk together through the seasons of life that ordinary discipleship requires.



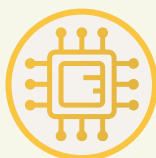
Planting Seeds Through Strategic Planning
