Be The Bridge
John 4:1-30
March 29/30

For the next two weeks, our discussion will focus on the sermon rather than a traditional Bible study.

Icebreaker Question: As a group, list ways to describe Jesus to someone who doesn't know Him personally.

Read John 4:1-30

Discussion Questions:

1. Before diving into the discussion questions, take a few minutes to share your general impressions of the passage.
2. Pastor Rodney shared nine key points about evangelism based on Jesus' interaction with the woman at the well. Tonight, we'll work through the first seven. (Next week, we'll have a separate discussion on the five cries of our culture.)
 1. Evangelism is about Building Relationships - *How are relationships the foundation for sharing about Jesus?*
 2. Evangelism Doesn't Happen by Accident, it's Intentional - What does intentionality in evangelism look like to you?
 3. Evangelism Knows No Boundaries - What barriers—cultural, social, or personal—often keep us from sharing the gospel?
 4. Find Common Ground—What are some practical steps we can take to connect in our faith and everyday relationships?
 5. Evangelism Helps Us Remember Our Need for Living Water—How does evangelism renew and strengthen our relationship with Jesus?
 6. Evangelism Offers Us The Opportunity To See People as God Sees Them - What challenges do we face in seeing people as God sees them?
 7. Evangelism is when the Living Water in us Flows Through us. How do you stay connected to the power of the Spirit when you're sharing your faith with others?

Application: Spend time praying for your heart to be broken for those who don't know Jesus. Ask the Lord to give you discernment, boldness, and the motivation to be a bridge, leading those around you to Him.
