## EASTER 2026

This Easter season was a special one at Christ's Church.

We welcomed 1,137 people on Easter Sunday—our highest attendance since before COVID and 85 more than last year. Good Friday services saw 397 attend, an increase of 100 from last year. At our Great Hunt, we had the opportunity to welcome around 700 people into our building, where families heard the story of Jesus' death and resurrection before heading outside for the hunt.

We're grateful for how God continues to work in and through Christ's Church. Seeing more people connect through these moments is a reminder of His faithfulness and the impact of simply creating space for others to come and experience hope.

It was a blessing to welcome so many guests and families that weekend. Whether they came searching for community, connection, or something more, we invite you to join us in praying for them—that they would continue to seek Jesus, the one who brings peace beyond understanding, calm in the chaos, and the hope of redemption and restoration.

### UPDATE FROM MISSION PARTNER: AIM

Across Southeast Asia and Central America, lives are being changed through prevention, care, and restoration.

In Southeast Asia, our mission partner, AIM, recently led four anti-trafficking education sessions in local villages, equipping 217 people with practical tools to protect themselves and others. In Central America, caregivers created space for healing by providing survivors with things like back pain therapy and routine eye exams.

These moments may seem simple, but they matter deeply. Real transformation is happening as people are protected, cared for, and walked alongside with hope.
