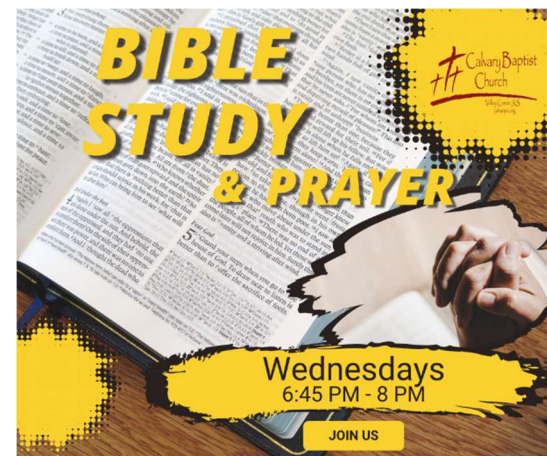
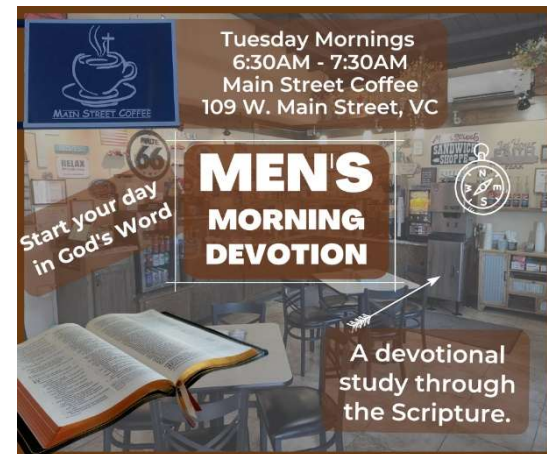
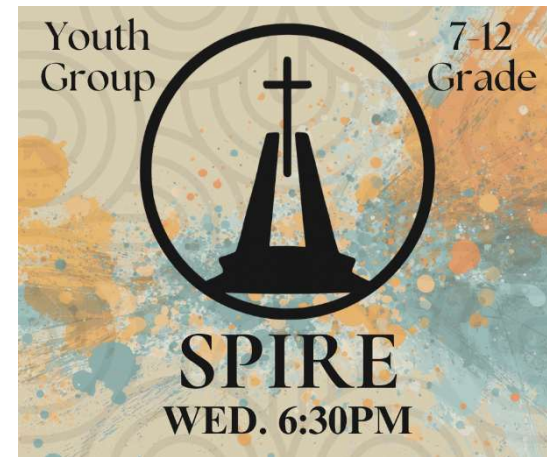

Islam has been entrenched for 1,000 years with little challenge. Mauritians see their nation as the most Islamic country in Africa. Many are the barriers to change – laws hindering proclamation of the gospel, powerful social resistance to change, an historic reluctance to engage with the outside world, geographical isolation, low literacy and minimal exposure to Christians and Christian media. The arrest of alleged converts to Christianity in 2023 highlights the hostility to even the notion of Mauritians leaving Islam. Pray for greater spiritual openness and hunger for God.
