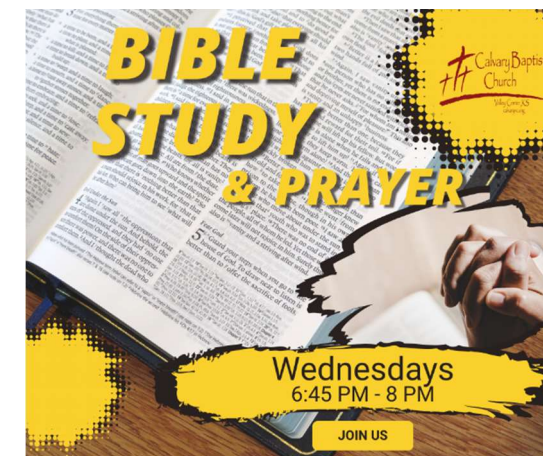
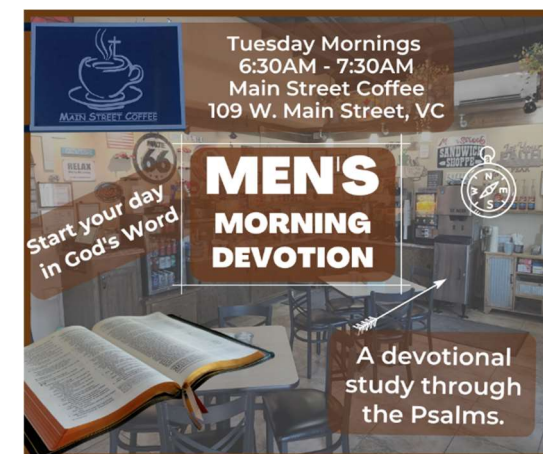
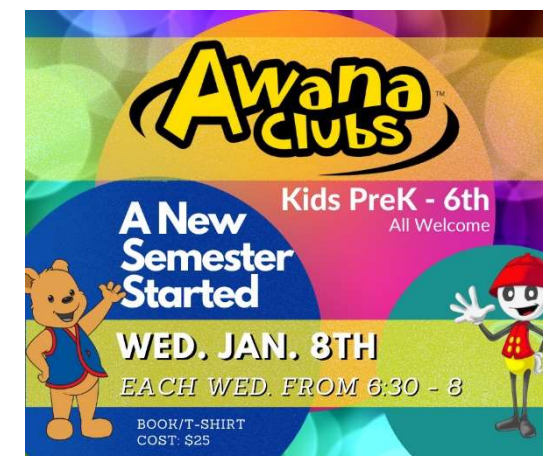
Missions: Prayer for believers & missions in Ethiopia. Population: 129,719,719



Corruption increased with economic growth, and a wide gap now exists between the few who are rich and the many who are poor. From 2020, devastating civil conflict – along ethnic lines – erased much of the progress of recent years. The Tigray region was attacked by both Ethiopian and Eritrean forces, under the banner of rooting out terrorist groups. Tigrayans describe it is genocide. While the violence has abated somewhat, the humanitarian crisis remains intense with 20 million people affected by the conflict. Pray for an end to the terrible violence, & a peace that offers esteem to every region and ethnic group while also enabling a genuine national unity.
