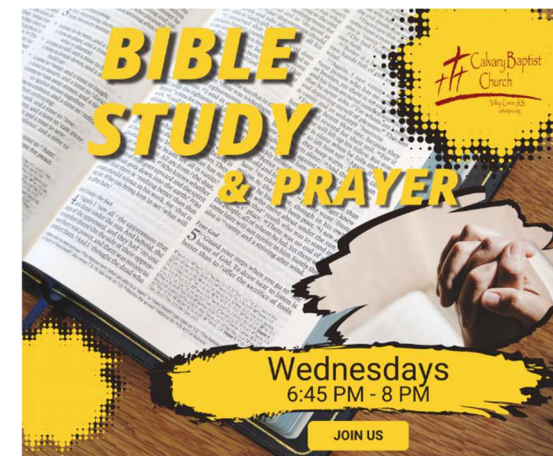
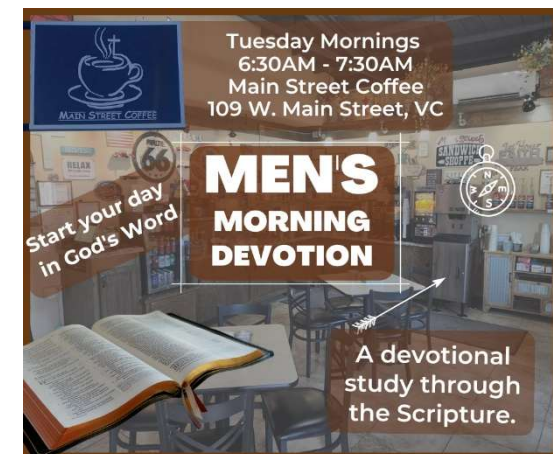
Missions: Pray for believers & missions in Pakistan. Pop: 255,220,000
