


Mountain View Culpeper Campus Renovation Plan Update 2021

After a year of prayer, planning, and consulting with county officials, the Elders presented the renovation plan for the Student Center at our Culpeper Campus at the annual MVCC Family Meeting. Under the theme, Fixer Upper Church Edition—Season 1: The

Student Center, the Elders laid out the necessary plans and costs of the needed renovation of our Student Center at the Culpeper Campus.


Over a year ago, we were informed by Culpeper County building officials that our facility was out of compliance. As a result of purchasing the facility, our zoning changed from light industrial to assembly, based on the way we use the facility. With that new zoning came more stringent safety regulations. The Elders presented options to the church family last November, but with more specific instructions from the county this January, the Elders realized we needed to begin renovations in the Student Center at our Culpeper Campus to bring our building into compliance.

The approved building plans were presented to the church showing the restart of the renovation of the sixth bay at the Culpeper Campus that is slated to be a worship video café, which will allow for multiple uses both on Sunday morning as well as throughout




Center and the addition of six new classrooms/meeting spaces, second floor bathrooms, and a system of egress from the second floor that will allow for two ways down from the second floor in case of an emergency. This was another requirement

the week. It was also noted that during the renovations of the Student Center, this bay would be used to temporarily facilitate our MVCC Kidz program on Sunday mornings. The plans also include sprinklers to be added in phases beginning with the Student



to bring our facility into compliance. This renovation is expected to take approximately twelve weeks and could begin as early as January 2021.

Once the plans were approved by the county, the Elders bid the work to area contractors and the winning bids were tabulated to reveal the price of the renovation. The total for the renovation will cost an estimated \$330,000, as noted on the image below.



The Elders asked that everyone at MVCC do two things:

PRAY: This is a huge faith step for the MVCC family as we begin 2021. We are already excited about the new mission and ministry ventures funded by our 2021 budget. On top of those opportunities, we are asking the MVCC church family to prayerfully

consider how everyone, from all campuses, can help make this needed renovation a reality.

SAVE YOUR SEAT: To help your prayer effort, the Elders and staff invited everyone to

consider joining together in person or online on Friday, Dec 11 at 7PM for what is being called **Fixer Upper—A Christmas Special**. This is a Christmas fundraiser event for the entire family. It is set to be a night that the MVCC family won't soon forget. This gathering will be filled with sweet treats, fun, laughter, and inspiration—all focused on bringing the family together to have fun, to more clearly understand the new and



innovative ways these new spaces will be used to help MVCC fulfill its mission, and to begin to raise funds for the renovation project. The staff will outline in written form several ways these newly renovated facilities will help us, in the short-term and long-term, more effectively fulfill the mission God has given us as a church—in part..."To Make Jesus Known."

All campuses are included in this event. This event will be live streamed following the dessert reception through our website (starting at approximately 7:30PM)—allowing everyone to participate in the events of the night—with one exception. If you are joining us from home, you'll need to purchase your own desserts. Everything else will be provided.
