

Potential Uses for Renovated Space

Classroom Space

- Small-group meeting areas for Kidz View and Revolution will allow for more effective discipleship through smaller groups (providing a more comfortable atmosphere for sharing and participation).
- Space for the Unlimited (special needs) ministry.
- The opportunity for restructuring the age groups of our youth to create a 5th and 6th grade classroom. This will lessen the huge age gap between kindergarten and 5th grade students currently in Kidz View, and free up needed space in Kidz View and Surge to accommodate more students. This would also foster a smoother transition into Surge and Revolution, as a result of the relationships formed in targeted age groups.

Office Space

- Repurposing space in our current office area will allow us to create a small room for our Lay Counseling Team and Pure at Heart ministries to offer counseling in a private setting, as well as a place to pray with people as needs arise.
- Creating two additional offices will offer our staff much needed space to prepare for ministry.

Student Center

- A more finished appearance in this space will be more inviting and minimize the “warehouse” feel. It will also be better insulated thus providing more efficient and cost-effective HVAC operation.

Life Groups

- Providing greater meeting spaces would make it possible for multiple Life Groups to meet throughout the week and share childcare ministry.

Nursing Moms

- Providing a special place where nursing moms, or moms who have a baby who is a little too fussy for the service, to go and still be able to watch the service shows a level of care and investment in the needs of young families.

MOPS

- Participants are currently limited due to space limitations. What a blessing to be able to offer a greater outreach through expanded meeting areas.

Filming Studio

- Having designated space to meet quality filming needs and stay current in the digital age allows us to be more effectual in spreading the Gospel and connecting the church (onsite and online) to the various areas of ministry.
- This readily available space would provide a “safe place” for our expensive equipment and a workspace for trained Ministry Partners.

Music Lab

- Restructuring of our space will provide the ability to break into small groups and host worship labs more efficiently.

Worship Café

- Creating a casual and welcoming space to come drink coffee and explore Christianity as we engage the community and culture in guided, face-to-face discussions on various biblical, social, economic, or community topics.
- Smaller, less formal environment to worship on Sunday mornings.
- Providing a good community space during the week and not just a “church space.”
