The new year of Revolution begins. Students now in sixth grade are now eligible to start attending!

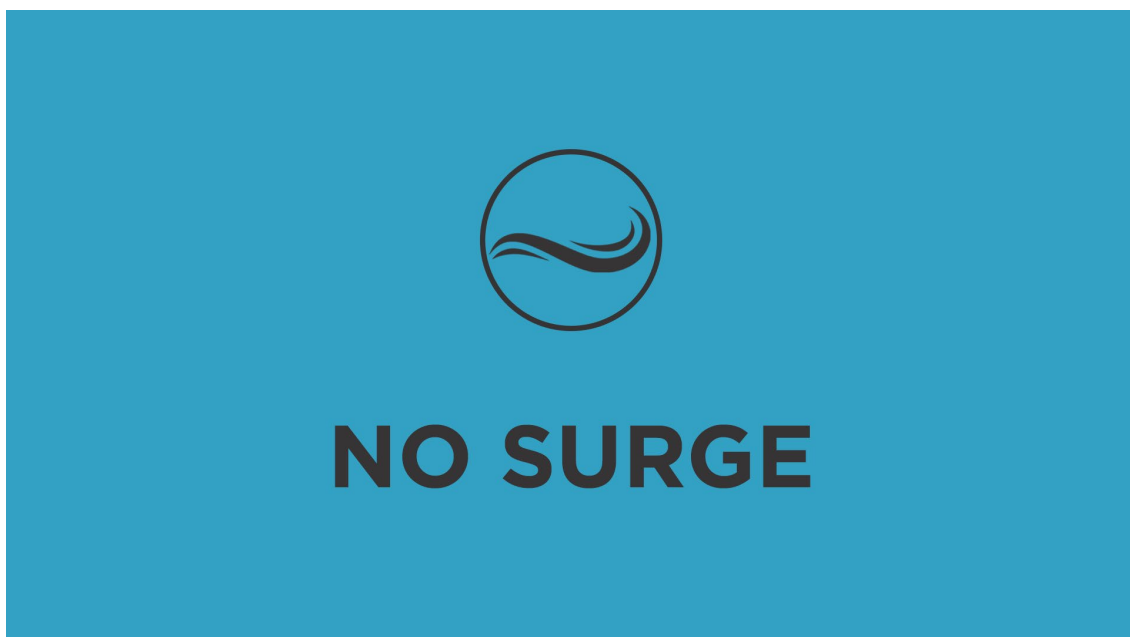
