## INGREDIENTS

1 can of biscuit dough    4 cups of oil    1 cup of honey    Sprinkles

## DIRECTIONS

1. Cut the biscuit dough into 1 inch pieces and form into balls.
2. Heat the oil over medium heat.
3. Place dough balls into oil and cook for 3 minutes or until golden brown.
4. Remove the dough balls and transfer to a bowl.
5. Pour the honey onto the dough balls and lightly stir until coated.
6. Arrange the dough balls in a wreath shape and top with sprinkles.
