A MIRACLE OF CHANGE

Read [John 2:1-11]. What did Jesus' mother say to the servants? What was lacking? What did Jesus fill?

Here, Jesus turns the ordinary into the extraordinary. The servants received instruction from the One who could fill the jars with better things. Is there an area of your life where you need to ask the Lord to remind you of His presence and care?

Take some time to turn your needs over to Him.

Ask the Lord for His direction, and commit to follow what He says to do.

A MIRACLE OF SIGHT

Read [Luke 18:35-43]. What was the blind man doing as he was sitting by the road? What was lacking? What did Jesus fill? Who received the glory when the man's sight was restored?

Recall a time when you have seen God meet a need in your life. Spend some time now praising Him for His restoration, presence, and provision.

LISTEN & RESPOND:

Bring your needs to our God who hears. Praise Him for who He is and what He has done.

Lord, help me to see Your power, recognize Your presence, and follow Your ways. Thank you for being attentive to my prayers. I want to continually praise You for who You are and what You do. Amen.



FILLED-UP BRUSCHETTA

3 beefsteak tomatoes, diced
1/4 cup red onion, chopped
1 large garlic clove, minced
olive oil
salt/pepper
fresh basil, chiffonade
balsamic vinegar
ciabatta baguette, sliced
Stracciatella (cheese) or cottage cheese
balsamic glaze for finishing

- Drizzle sliced ciabatta with olive oil and sprinkle with salt. Toast in a 375° oven for 6 minutes on each side. Let cool.
- Mix tomatoes, onion, garlic, olive oil, salt/pepper, basil, and vinegar.
- Assemble, spreading cheese on the toasted bread and topping with tomato mixture. Finish with a sweet balsamic glaze drizzle and a final pinch of salt.
