Welcome Home Team

The Welcome Home team exists to **welcome people** to Journey Church **the way Jesus welcomes us** all from the parking lot to the seat.

1. SECTION HOST

The Section Host Team works to **provide an environment of connection and care in the sanctuary** before and after the Sunday Gathering.

- Provide a warm welcome to individuals in your 'section' of the sanctuary by **initiating conversation and prayer**, and **providing information on upcoming events** at Journey Church.
- Be available to **connect with people outside of the Sunday Gathering** (i.e. email, phone calls, coffee meetings, etc).
- Arrive **15 minutes early & stay 15 minutes late**

2. 'NEW HERE' TENT

The New Here Tent **fosters an environment of belonging** through **engaging conversations** and **personalized assistance**.

- **Help first time guests feel at home** by asking others-focused questions, **answering questions** they may have about Journey Church, & **connecting them to other partners or staff members** (must be able to arrive 30 minutes early & stay 15 minutes late).

3. CAFÉ TEAM

The Café Team **serves coffee and refreshments** for each service while striving to **foster community and connection** in every interaction.

- **Engage with individuals as you serve refreshments** leading up to the church service.
- **Arrive 30 minutes early** to set up and prepare refreshments, and **stay 15 minutes late** to clean up after the service.

4. GREETING

The Greeting Team strives to **create a welcoming environment** where guests and partners feel at home **at each transition point in the building**.

- Arrive 30 minutes early to **hold outside and sanctuary doors open** and engage guests with friendly conversation.
- **Distribute various materials** as necessary to those entering the building or sanctuary

Family Meal Team

Our mission is to **'set the table' for our partners to receive the ordinance of communion** by ensuring its **preparation, distribution, and clean-up.**

1. COMMUNION COORDINATOR

The Communion Coordinator will **ensure that each service is fully staffed** and runs smoothly.

- **Ensure all volunteer positions are filled** each Sunday and **communicate with volunteers** as needs arise.
- Be **available to fill-in** at any communion station as needed.

2. PREPARATION

A Preparation Volunteer will **ensure that all communion elements are prepared and ready** for the service.

- Swaddle the bread, pour the juice, and **deliver elements** to each of the six stations in the sanctuary for service
- **Arrive 30 minutes early** to prepare the elements & **stay 15 minutes late** to clean stations/replace elements for additional services.

3. BAKING

A Baking Volunteer will **bake six loaves of bread for the communion service**

- Commit to **bake bread** for the Family Meal **for one month at a time.**
- Must be able to deliver bread to the church by **Sunday at 8:30AM.**

4. SERVING

Serving Volunteers are Partners in good standing with Journey Church who **serve the elements of the Family Meal**

- Retrieve elements and **stand at designated stations during the Family Meal** portion of the Sunday service, serving with **eye contact and a verbal reminder of the broken body and shed blood of Christ.**
- **Ten Partners are needed per service** to serve the Supper.
- Sign up for at least **two weeks at a time** on Planning Center Online.

Worship and Production

Journey Church Worship and Production exists to create environments and events where our congregation can **worship without distraction** and **respond to who God is and what He has done**.

1. BAND MEMBER

A Worship band member serves the congregation by **using their musical talent to lead the church in song**.

- **Come prepared**, knowing your parts and the flow of service.
- *Currently we need **two more guitar players** and **one more male vocalist**.*
- Must be available for **Thursday night rehearsal**.

2. PRODUCTION MEMBER

The production team **ensures that the tools we use for the Sunday Gathering** – such as the sound system, microphones, screens, and cameras – **operate effectively and without distraction**.

- **Trouble-shoot and operate production software and equipment.**
- Currently need is volunteers to serve on **cameras, audio, and slides**.
- Must be available for **Thursday night rehearsal**.

Journey Kids

Journey Kids exists so that the children of our church have multiple opportunities to see, hear, and respond to the gospel. We do this by **partnering with families** to **develop our children to be disciples and deploy them** to be godly influences where they live, learn, and play.

To provide a safe and welcoming environment for our children, all Next Generation volunteers must fill out an application, send references, receive a background check, and familiarize themselves with our procedures through specific training and volunteer shadowing.

1. Nursery (Newborn - 18 months)

A Nursery volunteer helps infants and toddlers **feel God's love and feel safe in God's family** through healthy touch, a small Bible lesson, and play.

- The Nursery room needs **2-3 volunteers** per service.

2. Preschool (19 months - Kindergarten)

A Preschool volunteer helps preschoolers **know God's love and meet God's family** through video Bible stories, creative activities, and an interactive worship experience.

- Preschool needs **one Lead Teacher** per service who will study provided materials before teaching Sunday's lesson.
- Preschool needs **1-2 Small Group Leaders** to assist with groups and activities per service.

3. Elementary (1st - 5th Grades)

An Elementary volunteer helps students **deepen their knowledge of God and His Word** through small group, worship, and engaging activities.

- Elementary needs **four Small Group Leaders** per service.
- Elementary needs **one Lead Teacher** per service who will study provided materials before teaching Sunday's lesson.
- Elementary needs **more members** of the praise team to serve as they are available .

4. First Impressions

A First Impressions volunteer **welcomes families home** by greeting parents on Sunday mornings, assisting them with check in, and providing a tour of the kids' space to new families.

- The First Impressions team needs **two volunteers** per service.

5. Supply Team

The Supply Team helps children to have an **inviting and distraction free environment** on Sunday mornings by preparing materials, activities, and classrooms throughout the week.

- The Supply Team needs volunteers who are **available to assist throughout the week.**
 - The Supply Team will engage in activities such as printing, sorting, organizing, and gathering supplies.

6. Encouragement Team

The Encouragement Team writes handwritten cards for kids and volunteers to **provide specific encouragement, and birthday celebration.**

- Journey Kids will provide mailing labels, stamps, and cards that can be left with the staff to mail for you.

Journey Youth

Journey Youth equips Middle and High School students to **discern God's will and glorify God** through the **teaching of God's Word** and **building thriving relationships** with Student Disciple Makers.

To provide a safe and welcoming environment for our students, all Next Generation volunteers must fill out an application, send references, receive a background check, and familiarize themselves with our procedures.

1. Student Disciple Makers

A Student Disciple Maker builds thriving relationships with **4-6 assigned students** by leading discussion in **weekly Discipleship Groups** and keeping **regular communication** with students throughout the week.

- **Lead Sunday evening small group discussion** based on provided lesson materials.
- **Pray** for each student weekly.
- **Reach out** to each student twice a month.
- **Plan six group events** a year.
- Attend monthly group **leader meetings** and engage in **ongoing training** to become a better disciple-maker.

Journey Young Adults (JYA)

Journey Young Adults **equips and sends Young Adults** to be disciples who make disciples by devoting ourselves to the apostles' teaching, to the fellowship of the saints, to the breaking of bread, and to prayer.

1. Home Hosts

Home Hosts help support, connect, and integrate Young Adults into the life of the local church by **opening up their homes and providing meals**.

- Home Hosts **provide lunch** and **open up space to gather** in their homes monthly for JYA Servant Leaders.
- Host Homes **provide dinner monthly** for JYA's weekly gatherings on Monday nights.

Visual Media & Communication Team

Journey Church Visual Media helps share the Gospel by **telling the stories of life change**, capture moments, promote events, and communicate discipleship opportunities and paths **through visual and written content** (photography, videography, illustration, graphic design, and copywriting).

1. Photographer

- Captures photos of Sunday Gatherings and other events.
- Edits and uploads photos to Dropbox by Sunday evening.

2. Videographer

- Captures video of Sunday Gatherings, announcements, and other events with professional camera equipment and film lighting.

3. Video Editor

- Edits videos for announcements, event recaps, and Sunday Gatherings.
- Proficient in non-linear editing software such as Davinci Resolve, Final Cut Pro, or Adobe Premier.

4. Graphic Designer

- Designs announcement slides, flyers, and other designs for print and screen.
- Proficient in Adobe Creative Suite design software such as Illustrator, InDesign, and Photoshop.

5. Production Assistant

- Helps facilitate video and photography shoots by handling logistics, scheduling, setup, etc.

6. Social Media Content Creator

- Helps plan and execute Social Media content strategy.

Cleaning Team

The Cleaning Team exists to create a **welcoming environment for worship** by ensuring our church facilities are clean and well-maintained.

1. Cleaning Team Member

Members of the Cleaning Team serve throughout the week on an occasional basis to ensure that the lobby, bathrooms, kitchen, sanctuary, Journey Kids rooms, and Student Center are **clean and well maintained.**

- Tasks include vacuuming, mopping, wiping down surfaces, cleaning toilets, refilling supplies, and emptying trash.
