	Adam and Eve were created to live in total dependence on a loving and living God who would continue to bless them with LIFE.	

## But something drastic happened in the garden of Eden that affected all of us!

Though God had given man everything he needed, He also gave him the choice of being dependent upon God by choice, (the Tree of Life)

OR he could become dependent upon himself. (the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil.)

This choice is often called free will.

#### 2. SEPARATION FROM GOD, WHICH HE CALLS DEATH.

God placed his own breath (spirit) into Adam, thus giving Adam His own life which enabled him to depend upon God for everything He needed. By "eating" from the Tree of Life, he could continue to rely upon God for everything.

I am trusting You to live Your Eternal Life through me as You please.

When Adam and Eve, ate of the forbidden tree, they died.

## They became separated from God and His life. This is the consequence of living life independently of God.

Now they had to forge they own way through life and its challenges. They could no longer enjoy God's resources to energise them.

In so doing, they plunged every human being and their descendants into death, condemnation, and separation from God.

"Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:" Romans 5: 12 KJV

All descendants of Adam, including you and me, were born with the wrong kind of life, self-life, dead and separated from God.

The Bible calls this condition as being "in Adam," and in Adam we all die and by default have to live in the "flesh." (flesh is living by our own resources.)

In Adam, we are left to discover what we really need, love, security and significance, but man is left to find it on his own and will sometime discover that man's ways don't satisfy.

Man keeps looking for LIFE in the wrong places and comes up empty.

#### 3. ETERNAL LIFE IS Jesus Christ – a Person

Eternal life is not a place, it is a person. It is not somewhere we go or get to when we physically die, it is the life of a person, Jesus Christ, who comes to restore the fallen condition we inherited from Adam. (Adam's spiritual DNA)

"I am the resurrection and the life; he who believes in Me will live even though he were dead,"

John 11:25 KJV

"I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly." John 10:10

Jesus really came to not only forgive our sins, but to restore the life of God in us, because of our dead condition in Adam.

"Eternal Life" is more than just a long life; it is a whole new life (new DNA) - the very life of Jesus with no limitations of any kind. God's love is not limited to the worth or loveliness of the person or persons being loved.

John 3:16 says, "For God so loved the world, that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life." (Christ's Life)

Likewise, He is not limited in His patience, kindness and forgiveness or in any other way.

To have "Eternal Life" means that <u>you have the opportunity</u> to live a full and meaningful life. By faith in Him, you will be able to live a very meaningful life as Christ lives in you.

#### 4. KNOWING JESUS CHRIST (Eternal Life) IS POSSIBLE FOR YOU

"Now this is eternal life: that they may know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent."

John 17:3

In this verse Jesus prays to His Father that you may know (have fellowship with) His Father through knowing Jesus Christ Himself in you.

John 3:16 says, "For God so loved the world, that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life." (Jesus Christ)

"God gave His life for you, so that He could give His life to you, in order that He might live His life through you." (Ian Thomas)

Jesus modeled this way of living while He was here on earth.

Acts 2:22 says: "Men of Israel, listen to these words: Jesus the Nazarene, a man attested to you by God with miracles and wonders and signs which God performed through Him in your midst."

"Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father is in Me? The words that I say to you I do not speak on My own initiative. but the Father abiding in Me does His works. John 14:10

In the same way that Jesus trusted in the Father to live through Him, so it is that we can rely and trust in Him to live in us, to live His life through us.

"And this is the testimony: God has given us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. He who has the Son has the life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have the life."

1 John 5:11, 12

God is the **giver** of eternal life, which is in His Son, the Lord Jesus.

But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, even to those who believe in His name, who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God. John 1:12-13

We must become **receivers** of this life from God, by an act of our own volition and surrender to the Father.

By receiving this gift of life from the Father, we become His children, a believer, born of the Spirit of God, a new creation.
