Scriptural Holiness

“Make every effort to live in peace with everyone and to be holy; without holiness no one will see the Lord.”

Hebrews 12:14

In a conversation with someone recently, we talked about the distinction of Methodism. What separates a Methodist from another denomination or a non-denomination Christian. For most of my life, it was somewhat difficult to distinguish a Methodist from another mainline Christian. However, when we get down to it, I throw out three words: grace, growth, and gospel. Yes, these are a part of any church. However, the Methodist distinction is combining the three. As we have talked about Methodists place as much emphasis

on Prevenient Grace and Sanctifying Grace as Justifying Grace. Justifying Grace is when we receive Jesus and are justified in Christ before God. Sanctifying grace is a faith growth process of being set apart for God (or becoming more Holy). Prevenient Grace is the Holy Spirit working on someone who doesn't know Jesus, guiding them to be open to the Good News (the Gospel). Thus, when a disciple shares the scriptural truth (Good News of Jesus), the Prevenience of God readies their hearts to receive it.

Another summary of grace, growth, and gospel is the term scriptural holiness. John Wesley regularly stated that the job of a Methodist was to spread scriptural holiness

throughout the world.

A while back a leader in the Global Methodist Church suggested the vision and mission of the GMC should simply be to spread scriptural holiness. His reasoning was sound: this made our vision and mission distinctly Methodist. Otherwise, by the mere words, there was no distinction from other denominations and independent churches.

In September, the GMC held its first General Conference. They adopted a Book of Doctrine and Discipline, elected interim bishops, and updated the vision and mission! Now you'll find scriptural holiness in BOTH the Global Methodist vision and mission! What is your role in spreading scriptural holiness? What is One Hope's role?


