TWELVE WORDS

"I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you."

John 14:18

The heart of God, summed up in twelve words. Yes, 1 John 4:8 tells us that God is love. God is inescapably love. Jesus reminds us that God is perfect and challenges us to become perfect (Matthew 5:48). God's perfection, as well as the perfection of God in Jesus, is who God is. God is holy, and we are called to be holy as well (Leviticus 11:44-45, 1 Peter 1:16). God is love.

God is perfection. God is holy. Amen! And...the twelve words in John 14:18 are how God acts in his love, perfection, and holiness.

This week our Hope Builders reviewed Revelation 2:1-7. Upon discussion of Jesus' command to return to their first love, I shared that when I first read the Bible, I began to understand the love of God. This began a journey of growing in love.

I didn't even have to finish Exodus before the power of God's love rocked my world. When God's people, the Hebrews, were lost, God told them he wouldn't leave them, but chased after them to

draw them back.

When Israel and Judah abandoned God's ways, the Babylonians attacked and drug the leaders into exile. Through the prophet Jeremiah, God told them he wouldn't leave them orphaned, but would bring them home.

Later, when the world wandered from their Father, God sent the promised Messiah to bring them home once again.

When Jesus spoke at the last supper, twelve words summed up the heart of God. Whenever you feel estranged from your Father, let the Lord speak the twelve words of John 14:18 into you and know that's God's heart for you, for us, for all.

ASH WEDNESDAY WORSHIP


