“Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding.”

Proverbs 3:5-6

I had graduated from seminary and had been researching commentary, books, and studying the Bible for years to prepare for sermons, articles, and classes. After the blessing of all this knowledge that I had gained over time, I was going through some old boxes and came across some of my early sermons, pre-education.

I picked up a sermon (yes, back in those days I wrote out every word!) and started reading. There was a part of me who was embarrassed before I even began. I laughed to myself, “This is going to be rough. Why did I even deliver sermons before I had so much formal education and self-study? How can this be trusted??” In other words, the educated me was already mocking the uneducated me.

As I began reading, my demeanor shifted. I said that? How did I even know that?” As I worked my way through it, I realized that the words were not just my words, but also

the Holy Spirit speaking through me. I was not only stunned, but began reflecting on if I continued to be this open to the Spirit’s leading, instead of my own understanding!

Trusting in the Lord with all of our hearts means we rely on God, no matter our perceived expertise. Full trust means God leads every facet of our lives: our faith; our family and relationships; our mental, emotional, physical, and spiritual fitness; our financial decisions, and our future.
