HOLINESS OF LIFE: LIVING BY THE SPIRIT

“And those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. If we live by the Spirit, let us also keep step with the Spirit.” Galatians 5:24-25

Paul wrote the church in Galatia on some pretty straightforward matters. In Galatians 5, Paul talked about freedom in Christ. This was the same freedom that Jesus talked about in John 8:31-38. Jesus said that sinning causes us to be enslaved to sin. However, in the Son, we have freedom from sin. We also have the freedom to choose Jesus. We can choose to follow Jesus, even when our natural instinct is to choose what feels right in the moment.

Paul explains to the churches that they need to walk in the Spirit. The walking part is where it gets a little challenging. Walking in the Spirit vs. the flesh means living by our heavenly citizenship here on earth.

During the Lenten season, we are on a journey of Holiness of Heart and Life. First, we seek to have a holy heart that is set apart for God and be receptive to Jesus’ guidance. This is our time of prayer, fasting, repentance, devotions, and Bible study, .

Holiness of life is walking in the Spirit. This is the freedom to which Paul and Jesus were referring. Learning about and growing in faith

are so important, and an essential part of Lent. So, HOW do we walk the talk and “keep step with the Spirit”?

As a church, during Lent, we will help equip you to take it from the sanctuary to the street. Holiness of life is how we interact with others. Holiness of life is how we earn, spend, and save our money. Holiness of life is how we keep ourselves fit: physically, emotionally, mentally, and spiritually. Walking in the Spirit is applying God to every part of life.

When God works this holiness in our lives, we become freer to choose God, to live for Jesus, and to walk with the Spirit. May God give you a powerful and meaningful Lenten journey!

Everyone is encouraged to respond as this will assist us in planning and executing the best study options. Thank you!


