The Aptly timed arrival

God, the Creator and Savior, who does all things well and perfect, sent his son into the world at just the right time to redeem his fallen creation. December 25 is perfect today for celebrating the birth of Jesus Christ.

As Luke's Gospel begins with the birth of John the Baptist so the timeframe for December 25, begins with the Angel's announcement to Zechariah (Luke 1:13) that John the Baptist would be born. Traditionally that is celebrated near Yom Kippur -September 25. And the annunciation to the Virgin Mary is March 25 - when Elizabeth is six months with child (Luke 1:36). Nine months after the Angel Gabriel announced to Mary, Jesus is born in Bethlehem on December 25.

These dates align beautifully with biblical events (Creation, angelic visits, and festivals). In the fourth century, Augustine wrote that December 25 was a commonly accepted date to remember the Nativity of our Lord and Savior Jesus. (Sermon 194).

As we celebrate Christmas, trust in the God who works out all things well and allows us the grace to see his beauty and love - in the face of a newborn boy swaddled and lying in a manger.
