Prayers are referenced to scripture
for more elaborate prayer and study

Prayer is the engine that moves the great work of the church -
the mission of advancing the gospel

- Lord, we believe your Word: in Matthew 28:18-20 when you said “All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth. Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Ghost: Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world.
- We are to make disciples through evangelism, teaching and baptizing.
- We pray that your missionaries do not forget the “mission” in lieu of meeting the needs of people.
- Lord, we pray for missionaries to be spiritually prepared with development of recognition of the spiritual war.
- Eph 6:18-19 - Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints; (We DECLARE) that utterance may be given unto missionaries, that they may open their mouth boldly, to make known the mystery of the gospel.
- We pray that the missionaries of the world would have discernment for what God wants them to accomplish and prevent them from going to certain places just like in the Book

of Acts 16:6-10 when you Lord forbid Paul from going into Asia and gave him a dream to come into Macedonia.

- As your servants, missionaries, go and preach, saying, the kingdom of God is at hand help them trust You for provision and financial support just as Your Word says in Matt 10:9-10 “provide neither gold, nor silver, nor brass in your purses; Nor scrip for your journey, neither two coats, neither shoes, nor yet staves: for the workman is worthy of his meat.
- We pray for health and safety during travel just like you protected Paul in Acts 27:24 by sending an angelic visitor in the night during a storm at sea and reassured him that he would arrive at Rome. God give your missionaries great confidence in the midst of great danger. Every faithful son or daughter of God may pray “O Lord, I am thine; I serve thee; be my protector” Ps 16:1-2
- We pray for your missionaries Lord, an abundance of wisdom and discernment with love for those whom they will serve and share with. Eph 3:14-20 we claim strength
- We pray for the Spirit of God to open blinded eyes and that unbelievers would see Christ in all of His Glory. 2 Cor 4:4-6 ● Let the Work of the Holy Spirit go ahead of missionaries to prepare hearts of the lost to respond to Christ and be drawn to Him.
- Let there be a growth in spiritual development and strength through partner churches and missions with churches and organizations, pastors, and believers across the globe to send the gospel to the uttermost parts of the earth.
- We pray that God would open unto missionaries divine doors of utterance, to speak the mystery of Christ. Col 4:3-4 ● We pray for empowerment that utterance may be given unto missionaries, that they may open their mouth boldly, to make known the mystery of the gospel. Eph 6:19-20

- May Christians all over prayerfully respond to the call of the Spirit for missions on their lives.
- Help missionaries persevere by waiting upon the Lord so their strength is renewed and they may mount up with wings as eagles; run and not be weary; walk and not faint. Is 40:31
- Encourage your missionaries Lord that they shall not be afraid of evil tidings: their heart fixed, trusting in you. Ps 112:7 ● Make provision for your missionaries Lord. Supply all their needs according to your riches in glory by Christ Jesus. Phil 4:19
- Protect your servants Lord. Preserve them going out and their coming in from this time forth, and even for evermore. Ps 121:8 ● Your Word says they that who sows in tears shall reap in joy. For he that goeth forth and weepeth, bearing precious seed, shall doubtless come again with rejoicing, bringing his sheaves with him. Ps 126:5-6 so Lord give your mission servants joy in the midst of trials.
- Lift the darkness from this world so the anointed ones can preach good tidings unto the meek; let them bind up the broken-hearted, proclaim liberty to the captives, and open the prisons to them that are bound: Is 61:1
- Open up the hearts of the ones being ministered too that they will know You Lord, that they will be Your people, and You will be their God: for they shall return to You with their WHOLE heart. Jer 24:7
- Lord we pray that Your missionaries are confident in Your Word as they are sent forth by the Holy Ghost to preach Your Word. Acts 13:4-5
- Let them be filled with the Holy Ghost just as Paul was when he encountered a certain sorcerer, a false prophet. Acts 13:6-9 ● We pray they have victory in spiritual warfare when they confront the false prophets they encounter. Acts 13:10-12

- Let them have success in gospel witness that when they do Your work others will believe in You. Acts 13:12
- Let them have peace with other believers. Acts 13:13
- Let them have favor with unbelievers. Acts 13:14-15 ●
- Let them preach the gospel clearly. Acts 13:16-47 ● Let hearts be opened. Acts 13:48
- Let them show kindness in the midst of slander Acts 14:1-2 ● Bless them with Your supernatural power from on High. Signs and Wonders to be done by their hands. Acts 14:3 ● Give them Christ-like humility. Acts 14:8-18
- Let them have great perseverance during trials and suffering. Acts 14:19-20
- Let churches multiply for Your Glory Lord around the globe. Acts 14:24-28
