

# “Protection”

Then with power and authority from our Heavenly Father declare these scriptures over the situations. Speak to these mountains to be removed and cast into the sea. - Thank you Lord for being my hiding place; you will protect me from(insert your trouble) and surround me with songs of deliverance. (Psalms 32:7)
- For God you are our refuge and strength, and an ever-present help in trouble. (Psalms 46:1)
- Lord, I will be strong and courageous. I will not be afraid or terrified because of them, for the Lord my God goes with me; you will never leave me nor forsake me. (Deut 31:6)
- So I say with confidence, “The Lord is my helper; I will not be afraid. What can mere mortals do to me?” (Heb 13:6)
- I declare over myself, family, and church body that “no weapon forged against us will prevail, and you Lord will refute every tongue that accuses us. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord, and this is their vindication from me,” declares the Lord. (Isaiah 54:17)
- I put on the full armor of God, so that I can take **my** stand against the devil's schemes. (Eph 6:11)

- I will sing of your strength, in the morning I will sing of your love; for you are my fortress, my refuge in times of trouble. (Psalms 59:16) ● I keep my eyes always on the Lord. With him at my right hand, I will not be shaken. (Psalm 16:8)
- What, then, shall we say in response to these things If God is for us, who can be against us? (Romans 8:31)
- For it is better to take refuge in the Lord than to trust in humans. (Psalms 118:8)
- Every word of God is flawless; he is a shield to those who take refuge in him. (Proverbs 30:5) I believe your Word God.
- Lord your word says you will cover me with your feathers, and under your wings I will find refuge; your faithfulness will be my shield and rampart. (Psalm 91:4)
- For you Lord are good, a refuge in times of trouble. You care for those who trust in you. (Nahum 1:7) I put my trust in you right now. ● I know you Lord will rescue me(or insert person in trouble) from every evil attack and will bring me(them) safely to your heavenly kingdom. To you Lord be glory forever and ever Amen. (2Tim 4:18) ● Truly you are my rock and my salvation; you are my fortress, I will never be shaken. (Psalm 62:2)
- Do not withhold your mercy from me, Lord; may your love and faithfulness always protect me. (Psalm 40:11)
- For you guard the course of the just and protect the way of your faithful ones. (Prov 2:8) help me to be just and faithful to you Lord. ● For you Lord hold success in store for the upright, you are a shield to those whose walk is blameless. (Prov 2:7) help make me upright and blameless in your sight O Lord. Help me to see what you say success really looks like for me.
- Lord frustrate the ways of the wicked. (Psalm 146:9) ● Though they intended evil against us and devised a plot, They will not succeed. (Psalms 21:11)
- Do not grant, O Lord, the desires of the wicked; do not promote their evil device, that they not be exalted. (Psalms 140:8)
- Woe to those who scheme iniquity, who work out evil on their beds!

(Micah 2:1)

- In pride the wicked hotly pursue the afflicted; Let them be caught in the plots which they have devised. (Psalm 10:2)
- Lord I put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, I may be able to stand my ground, and after you have done everything, to stand. (Eph 6:13)
- For if anyone destroys God's temple, God you will destroy that person; for God's temple is sacred, and all of us together are that temple. (1Cor 3:17)

- Lord I submit to you O Lord God. I know that if I resist the devil, he will flee from me. So, I declare right now for resistance against the devil to rise up in me. (James 4:7)
- I lift my eyes to the hills. From where does my help come from? My help comes from You Lord, who made heaven and earth. You will not let your foot be moved; you keep me and you do not slumber. Thank You!(Psalms 121:1-8)
- Lord we know that we are of you, and the whole world lies in the power of the evil one. (1John 5:19)
- But you Lord are a hiding place for us; you preserve us from trouble; you surround us with the shouts of deliverance. (Psalms 32:7) ● Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me. (Psalm 23:4)
- ... I declare I will straighten up and raise my head, because my redemption is drawing near. (Luke 21:28)
- Help me Lord to be careful, so my heart will not be weighed down

with carousing, drunkenness and the anxieties of life, and that day of your coming will not close in on me suddenly like a trap. (Luke 21:34)

- Lord help me to watch and pray always, that I may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of man. (Luke 21:36)
