WE Pray that the youth of the world would . . .

- Commit their lives to you Lord, be filled with Your Holy Spirit, and be baptized in Your name.
- That they would recognize that Your name is above every name (Acts 4:12) and confess by a life fully submitted to divine authority that You are Lord of all (Philippians 2:11).
- Lord let them learn to communicate with You and learn to depend on You for everything.
- Show them the depths of Your love for them (I John 3:1).

- Base their self-esteem and identity in Christ and not the standards of the world.
- Show them and let them know who they are, what they have in Christ, and what they can do through Him (Colossians 1:27).
- Teach them how to be blessed with the joy that comes from intimately knowing Christ and walking with Him.
- Let them be filled so completely with the joy of the Lord that they would not pursue worldly pleasure (Romans 14:17; Psalm 16:11; Philippians 4:4; Nehemiah 8:10).

Lord we claim moral purity for our youth

“Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean: wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow. Make me to hear joy and gladness; that the bones which thou hast broken may rejoice. Hide thy face from my sins, and blot out all mine iniquities. Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me” (Psalm 51:7-10).

- Develop the strength of their character to remain morally pure in this permissive society.
- Direct them to make right decisions about sex, drugs, and worldly pleasures.
- Lord we come against in Jesus name negative peer pressure and ask you to help them learn how to make the right choices even when it is tough. We rebuke the devourer off of their life right now.
- We break every demonic attack, every tormenting spirit, every suicidal spirit, every cutting spirit, every emotional demon, every sexual demon, every rape spirit, every molestation spirit, every abandonment spirit, the spirit of rejection, every tormenting and scorning spirit of the mind. Any premature death spirits, lying, deceiving and seductive spirits, any alcohol spirits and any pharmakeia spirits-we break your powers and grip now in the name of Jesus.

- Give them the desire to please God in all they do.

- Let the Word of God be instilled in their hearts that they would choose the obedience of hating sin and loving His holiness.

Lord we cover our youths' Values and Relationships

- Let them retain the biblical values and learn to live by the biblical principles of integrity and honesty—to be true, especially in relationships. (Titus 2:11-14).
- Help them to develop friendships based on the drawing of the Holy Spirit to righteous companions.
- We pray God, You would give them friends who are true, wholesome, and mutually encouraging.
- We pray that they would have the wisdom to choose relationships that would honor God (Psalm 119:63; John 15:13-14).
- Set their thoughts on what is true, noble, right, pure, lovely, admirable, excellent, and worthy of praise (Philippians 4:8; John 8:32; Romans 12:2).

Lord give our youth a heart to preach the gospel!

“And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned” (Mark 16:15-16).

- Show them and help them accept their divine mission in life. They were born again to be a witness for Jesus Christ and to disciple others (Acts 1:8).
- Lord, mold them into spiritual leaders and boldly; courageously they will stand up for what they believe and cherish (I Timothy 4:12).

We claim and declare over our youth a release of:

- **A spirit of humility.** "The willingness to submit" Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up.(James 4:10).
- **A spirit of reverence.** "To fear the Lord" The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the holy one is understanding. (Proverbs 9:10).
- **A spirit of purity.**"A desire to be clean"Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God. (Matthew 5:8).
- **A spirit of purpose.**"A wisdom to set goals" Let thine eyes look right on and let thine eyelids look straight before thee.(Proverbs 4:25).
- **A spirit of simplicity.**"A lifestyle uncluttered" he that exhorteth, on exhortation: he that giveth let him do it with simplicity: he hath ruleth with diligence; he that sheweth mercy with cheerfulness. (Romans 12:8).
- **A spirit of commitment.**"A dedication to the 'cause'" And if it seem evil unto you to serve the Lord, choose you this day whom you will serve: whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord. (Joshua 24:15).
- **A spirit of diligence.**"A willingness to work hard" And beside this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge; (2 Peter 1:5) ● **A spirit of servanthood.**"The ministry of helps" And let us not be weary in

well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not. (Galatians 6:9).

- **A spirit of consistency.**"The quality of faithfulness"because a double minded man is unstable in all his ways. (James 1:8).
- **A spirit of assurance.**"A depth of faith"Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water. (Hebrews 10:22).
- **A spirit of availability.**"A willingness to go" Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying, Whom shall I send, and who will go for us? Then I said, Here am I; send me. (Isaiah 6:8).
- **A spirit of loyalty.**"A zeal for fidelity" And Ruth said, Intreat me not to leave thee, or to return from following after thee: for whither thou goest, I will go; and where thou lodgest, I will lodge: thy people shall be my people and thy God my God: (Ruth 1:16).
- **A spirit of sensitivity.**"Openness of heart for those who are hurting" Just like the Good Samaritan did.
- **A spirit of compassion.**"Love in action just like Jesus had compassion on the multitude."(Mark 8:1-2).
- **A spirit of tenderness.**"A willingness to weep Just like King Josiah humbled himself before the Lord and wept"(2 Kings 22:19).
- **A spirit of maturity.**"The capacity to grow" Let the Word of God discern their thoughts and intents of the heart and let them hold fast their profession of faith.(Hebrews 5: 12-14).

- **A spirit of holiness.**"Christ-like behavior" Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy.(1 Peter 1:16).
- **A spirit of reliability.**"A depth of dependability" it is required in stewards that a man be found faithful. (1 Corinthians 4:2).
- **A spirit of revelation.**"Learning to listen" Let their eyes of understanding be enlightened; that they may know what is the hope of their calling (Ephesians 1:15,18).
- **A spirit of self-denial.**"A sacrifice to surrender" To deny themselves, and take up their cross daily, and follow Jesus(Luke 9:23).
- **A spirit of confidence.**"A baptism of boldness" For one can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth them. (Philippians 4:13).
- **A spirit of integrity.**"The quality of truthfulness" To provide things honest in the sight of all men. (Romans 12:17).
- **A spirit of repentance.**"A willingness to change" To bring forth fruits worthy of repentance.(Luke 3:8).
- **A spirit of trust.**"A fearless reliance" For they that trust in the Lord shall be as mount Zion, which cannot be removed, but abideth forever. (Psalm 125:1).
- **A spirit of submission.**"Choosing to yield" Submitting themselves one to another in the fear of God. (Ephesians 5:21).
- **A spirit of teachability.**"A quality of meekness" To speak evil of no man, to

be no brawlers, but gentle, shewing all meekness unto all men. (Titus 3:2).

- **A spirit of prayer.**"A longing to wait" They that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint. (Isaiah 40:31).

- **A spirit of unity.**"A respect for others" That they are perfectly joined together with other Christians in the same mind and in the same judgement (1 Corinthians 1:10).

- **A spirit of restoration.**"A ministry of healing" Lord anoint them to preach good tidings unto the meek; and to bind up the broken-hearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives and the opening of the prison to them that are bound. To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all that mourn; (Isaiah 61:1-2).

- **A spirit of authority.**"A capacity to command " Let them receive what you have for them, the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven. (Matthew 16:19).

- **A spirit of generosity.**"The desire to give" To heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely received so freely give.(Matthew 10:8).

We seal our young people in the words of Psalms 91 and in the blood of Jesus, and we ask God to release angels to arrest every devil, never to return

in Jesus name. We call back every piece from the enemy's camp; we call back from the north, south, east, and west in Jesus' name.
