

BEREAVEMENT

This team offers comfort to grieving families by providing a meal following the death of a loved one. Working in consultation with the family's wishes, this group organizes meals and coordinates volunteers who wish to contribute a dish or help serve.

CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

Partnering with the Children's Minister, this group helps cast the vision for our children's ministry and meets periodically to ensure we are moving in the right direction. Members are active leaders who help recruit volunteers and serve across our weekly programs, from Wednesday nights to Sunday morning worship and education. Beyond weekly services, this group helps bring special events and outings to life.

DECORATIONS

Using flowers, banners, and seasonal decor, this creative group enhances our worship spaces to reflect the beauty of God and the spirit of the season. Volunteers help create and place arrangements throughout the church buildings.

FOOD PANTRY

This passion group is open to all folks interested in helping with our food pantry ministry. Members of the group are considered the official Food Pantry Board and help make decisions as to how to best meet the needs of our community. In addition to semi-regular meetings, the board coordinates our disbursement on the third Wednesday of each month,

packing bags earlier in the week, and stocking the pantry throughout the month. Additionally, this passion group coordinates our weekly Backpack Ministry at Williamsburg Independent School.

GREET, EAT, & MEET (G.E.M.)

This group hosts a monthly lunch for our senior adults, creating a wonderful time of food, fellowship, and engaging programs. Volunteers help with planning, setup, and providing a warm, welcoming atmosphere. The group usually takes time off from Nov. through March. TECHNOLOGY

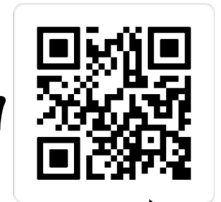
