

BEREAVEMENT

This team offers comfort to grieving families by providing a meal following the death of a loved one. Working in consultation with the family's wishes, this group organizes meals and coordinates volunteers who wish to contribute a dish or help serve.

CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

Partnering with the Children's Minister, this group helps cast the vision for our children's ministry and meets periodically to ensure we are moving in the right direction. Members are active leaders who help recruit volunteers and serve across our weekly programs, from Wednesday nights to Sunday morning worship and education. Beyond weekly services, this group helps bring special events and outings to life.

DECORATIONS

Using flowers, banners, and seasonal decor, this creative group enhances our worship spaces to reflect the beauty of God and the spirit of the season. Volunteers help create and place arrangements throughout the church buildings.

FOOD PANTRY

This passion group is open to all folks interested in helping with our food pantry ministry. Members of the group are considered the official Food Pantry Board and help make decisions as to how to best meet the needs of our community. In addition to semi-regular meetings, the board coordinates our disbursement on the third Wednesday of each month,

packing bags earlier in the week, and stocking the pantry throughout the month. Additionally, this passion group coordinates our weekly Backpack Ministry at Williamsburg Independent School.

GREET, EAT, & MEET (G.E.M.)

This group hosts a monthly lunch for our senior adults, creating a wonderful time of food, fellowship, and engaging programs. Volunteers help with planning, setup, and providing a warm, welcoming atmosphere. The group usually takes time off from Nov. through March.

HOSPITALITY

This group shares the love of Jesus through food and fellowship. Their goal is not only to feed the body but to nourish the soul through personal interaction. Volunteers host our annual Easter Breakfast and Thanksgiving Dinner, as well as various luncheons and picnics throughout the year.

LIBRARY

This team manages the Florence Young Library and Heritage Room, a resource open to both our congregation and the community. Volunteers help curate a collection of books and media that challenge us, inspire our faith, and encourage a love of literature.

NURSERY

This team creates a safe and nurturing environment for our youngest children, from birth to

preschool. Volunteers care for children with love, encouraging play while teaching them about God's love and how to care for one another.

PEACE BY PIECE QUILTING

This ministry transforms donated fabric into beautiful lap quilts, baby quilts, and fidget pads for those in need. These handmade items bring warmth and love to their recipients. No quilting experience is necessary—just a desire to serve.

SAFETY TEAM

This team works to ensure our church is a safe and welcoming place for everyone. Volunteers help oversee and implement our safety protocols, from monitoring doors on Sunday mornings to assisting with any emergencies.

TECHNOLOGY

Working behind the scenes on Sunday mornings, this team manages the sound, video, and lighting that make our worship services accessible. Volunteers run the soundboard, operate cameras, and manage the livestream to our website, Facebook, and YouTube.

USHERS & GREETERS

As the first smiling faces you see on a Sunday morning, this team makes everyone feel at home. Greeters welcome people at the doors, while ushers assist with seating, answer questions. This group works on a rotating schedule and is always looking for new volunteers.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT (NEW TO 2026)

This passion group helps coordinate opportunities for the church to be active in outreach to our local community. They will work with church staff to help coordinate and implement events that help us connect with our neighbors.
