***Unoffendable: How Just One Change Can Make All of Life Better*
by Brant Hansen**

Although I first read *Unoffendable* by Brant Hansen about ten years ago, a recent conversation reminded me just how relevant it is in today's culture of constant outrage. With his trademark humor, Hansen challenges readers to let go of the exhausting cycle of "righteous anger" by remembering that God is ultimately in control and has already won the victory. Rather than becoming indifferent to the world's problems, he encourages believers to respond with faith, peace, and trust in God's provision.
