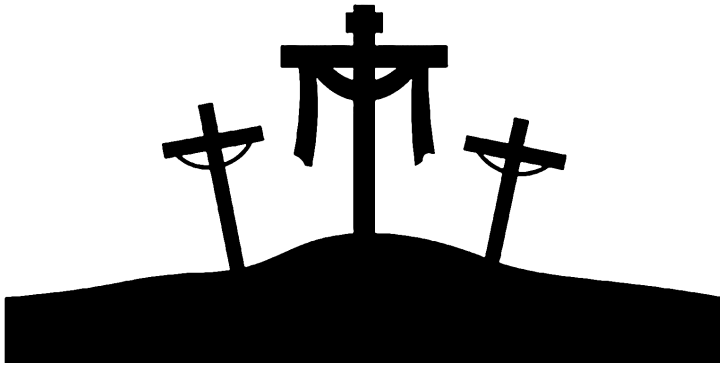

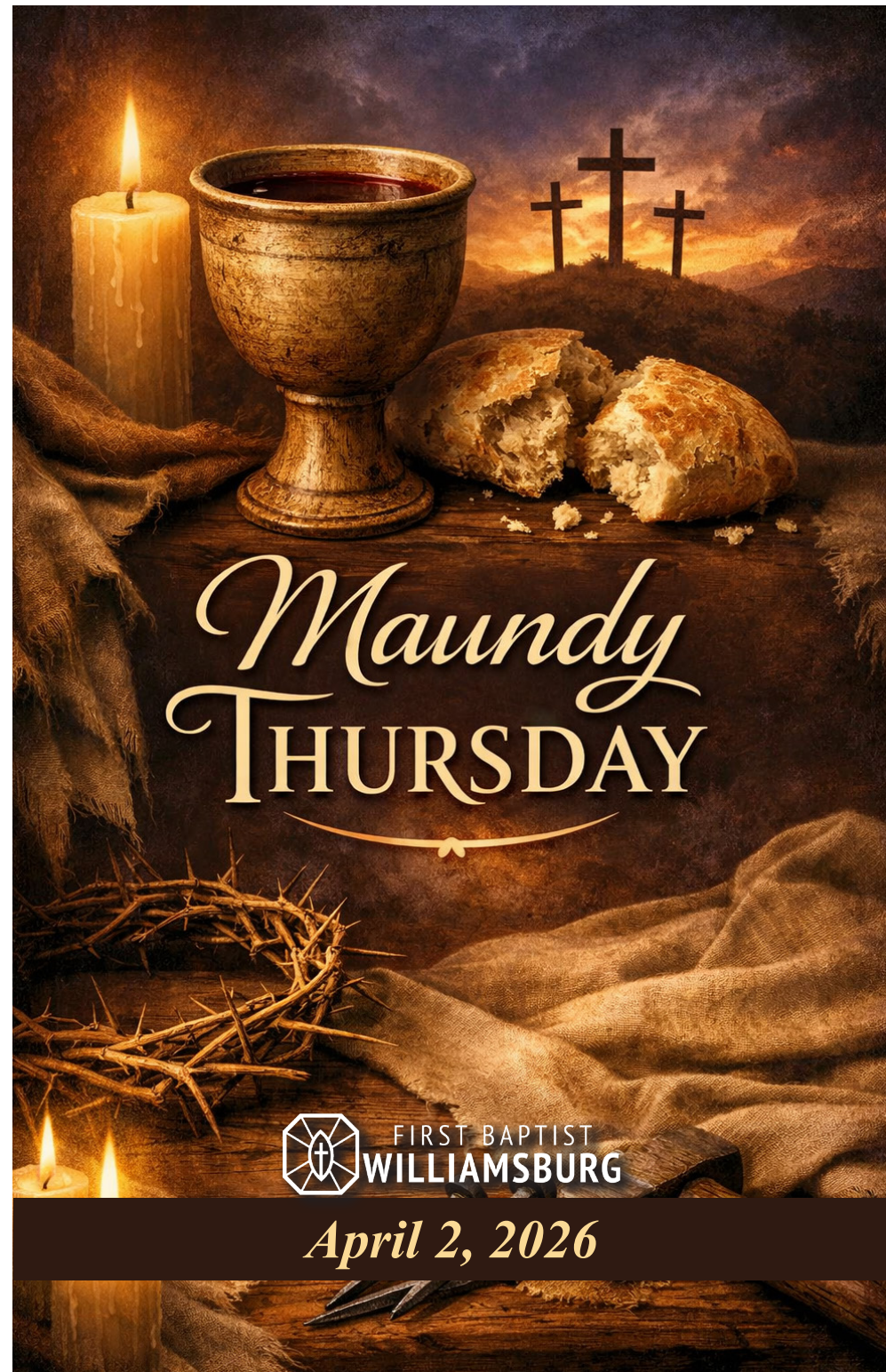

Leader: Before the Passover Festival, Jesus knew the hour had come to leave this world. Having loved his own who were in the world, he loved them to the end. He rose from the meal, poured water into a basin, and began to wash his disciples' feet. (John 13:1, 4-5)

***Congregation: You gave us an example that we should do as you have done. A new command you give us: Love one another. As you have loved us, so we must love one another. (John 13:15, 34)***

Leader: Jesus said, "Do not let your hearts be troubled. You believe in God; believe also in me. I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." (John 14:1, 6)

***Congregation: You are the vine; we are the branches. If we remain in you and you in us, we will bear much fruit; apart from you we can do nothing. (John 15:5)***

Leader: Jesus warned his disciples: "In this world you will have trouble. But take heart!" (John 16:33)

***Congregation: "I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. I have overcome the world." (John 16:33)***

Leader: Then Jesus looked toward heaven and prayed: "Holy Father, protect them by the power of your name. I pray that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. I in them and you in me - so that they may be brought to complete unity." (John 17:1, 11, 21, 23)

***Congregation: Then the world will know that you sent the Son, and that you have loved them even as you have loved him. (John 18:1)***

Leader: After saying these things, Jesus went out with his disciples across the Kidron Valley to a garden. The hour had come. (John 18:1)
