This includes maintaining an open and aware culture, treating all concerns and allegations seriously, not minimising the impact of abuse and harm on the victim, and promptly responding to all concerns and allegations.

Liberti Church is dedicated to providing a safe environment for all—especially children, young people and vulnerable adults—the Church commits to upholding the [National Principles for Child Safe Organisations](#). Specifically, Liberti Church is committed to fulfilling our responsibilities under the 8 Mandatory Requirements of a Child and Youth Risk Management Strategy, as set out by the Queensland Government Blue Card Services, and is informed by the Queensland Baptists denomination.
