“The Final Collapse of the Antichrist System”

HIS KINGDOM COME – PT 16

Pastor Matt Mylin - May 3, 2026

Revelation 18:1-24, Luke 17:26-30

1. He rules over all.
2. He removes what corrupts to restore God’s design.
3. He is awakening His church to live in daily submission to Him.
4. He is preparing His church today for His return.

Big Idea:

Revelation 18 shows the collapse of the antichrist system and calls us to live under the rule of Jesus, whose kingdom endures forever.

Connect and Engage:

- Take a few minutes for each person to share a recent high and low.

Read Revelation 18:1-24.

- This passage reveals that Babylon is an antichrist system. People are influenced by communities, political powers, leaders, and wealth. How do you see these influences impacting our communities? What is shaping/influencing you?
- We are warned that this worldly system will collapse, but we do not need to collapse with it. We can be free from what can, or does, enslave us. How does Jesus free us from what enslaves us?
- He is preparing a Kingdom that reflects His character. Take some time to reflect on: How you view money, how you define success, what you celebrate and tolerate, and how you handle ambition.

Apply:

What is one step you can take this week to prepare for His return?

Pray:

Ask God to help you consistently spend time in the Word and in prayer, fully submitting to Him, asking Him to define what is valuable.
