CONNECT > ENGAGE > SERVE

Small Group Meeting Guide

Big Idea:

Jesus is the victorious King whose reign and kingdom cannot be stopped.

Connect and Engage:

- Take a few minutes for each person to share a recent high and low.

Read Revelation 20.

- The message reminded us that Jesus secured Satan’s defeat at the cross. In what areas of life can it be difficult to live from that victory, and where do you need to believe this truth most today.
- Think back to when you first gave your life to Jesus or when your relationship with Him became real and personal. What do you remember about that season, and how has Jesus changed your life since then?
- Who is someone in your life right now that feels far from the Lord?
 - Create a list of names together to pray over throughout the week.
 - Consider committing to pray for them daily that they would encounter Jesus and respond to His love.
 - Look for opportunities to encourage or reach out to them this week.

Apply:

What is one practical way you sense God inviting you to submit more intentionally to Jesus and participate in His Kingdom this week through obedience, discipleship, prayer, serving, sharing your faith, or encouraging someone else?

Pray:

Pray for boldness and faithfulness in carrying out God’s Kingdom mission, for spiritually lost people to come to know Christ, and for each person in the group to live fully surrendered and anchored to Jesus.
