KINGDOM MISSION - PT 2

Acts 2:1-21, Acts 2:25-33, Acts 2:37-41

1. God fulfilled His promise to put His Spirit in His people.
2. Jesus conquered death to make a way for eternal life.
3. The Holy Spirit will change us so He can do something through us.

Reflection:

What is the evidence that the Spirit of God lives in you?

CONNECT > ENGAGE > SERVE

Small Group Meeting Guide

Big Idea:

Pentecost was God's fulfilled promise for His Spirit to dwell in His people so that He can continue Jesus' mission through them.

Connect and Engage:

- Take a few minutes for each person to share a recent high and low.
- When you hear that the event of Pentecost was a festival of harvest that Jewish culture celebrated each year (first mentioned in Leviticus 23:15), what thoughts come to your mind?
- Read Acts 2:16-21. Why did God promise to put His Spirit into His people? After hearing some responses, read Ezekiel 36:27 and continue to discuss this question.
- Peter shifted from misunderstanding Jesus' mission to explaining the gospel as God's Spirit was poured out on Him. Peter's instructions to the people gathered on that day were to repent, turn to God, be baptized, be forgiven of their sins, and receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. How have you shifted from misunderstanding Jesus to following Him wholeheartedly?

Apply:

The Holy Spirit changes us so that He can do something through us. Where will His presence go this week because you are willing to go there with Him?

Pray:

Pray for your group to yield to the Holy Spirit's outpouring upon them, evidenced by growing obedience, resisting temptation, sharing their salvation stories, and forsaking this world for the sake of God's Kingdom.
