“Awakened by God’s Warnings”

HIS KINGDOM COME - PT 6
Pastor Matt Mylin — February 8, 2026

Revelation 9:1-21, John 5:22-24, John 3:18-21, John 1:14

The trumpets are God’s warnings to awaken people from sleepwalking toward destruction.

What this passage reveals about Jesus:

1. He has the authority to execute judgment of evil.
2. He preserves those who belong to Him.
3. He exposes allegiance.
4. He remains patient even in judgment.

CONNECT > ENGAGE > SERVE*Small Group Meeting Guide*

Big Idea:

The trumpets are God’s warnings to give space for repentance before His judgment is final.

Connect and Engage:

- Take a few minutes for each person to share a recent high and low.
- Share one way you have been challenged or encouraged in your faith in Jesus through this study of Revelation so far.
- Read Revelation 9:1-21. Share a time when you had to turn from indifference to allegiance to Jesus. What steps did you take?
- Read John 5:22-24. How is honoring God reflected in your daily life?

Apply:

“Whoever is holding your attention is shaping your worship. Whatever holds your gaze holds your life.” Share what is holding your attention. What is one thing you can do this week to keep your attention on Jesus?

Pray:

Pray that you would keep your focus (gaze) on Jesus and pay attention to His voice.
