“Jesus Already Defeated the Enemy”

HIS KINGDOM COME - PT 9
Pastor Matt Mylin - March 8, 2026

Revelation 19:10b, Revelation 11:19, Revelation 12:1-18, Romans 8:33-39

What the passage reveals about Jesus:

1. Jesus governs His people by a new covenant relationship.
2. Jesus defeated the devil through the cross and resurrection.
3. Jesus made a way for His people to overcome the accuser.
 - The accusation of sin has been answered by the cross.
 - The answer for every accusation is “Look what the Lord has done!”
 - Your allegiance to Jesus is stronger than fear.

CONNECT > ENGAGE > SERVE

Small Group Meeting Guide

Big Idea:

Jesus has already won the decisive victory, and His people overcome the accuser through trusting His sacrifice and living with faithful allegiance to Him.

Connect and Engage:

- Take a few minutes for each person to share a recent high and low.
- Read Revelation 12:10-12. Your testimony is part of how you overcome the accuser. What is one area of your life where you have clearly seen the Lord at work?
- What kinds of accusations or lies tend to show up in your thoughts about God, yourself, or your future?
- Read Romans 8:33-39. Share one way this scripture impacts your faithful allegiance to Jesus.

Apply:

How have you kept your focus on the eternal? What choices or changes can you make this week to improve your eternal focus?

Pray:

Pray that we would shift our focus from the temporary to the eternal, so that we don't live in fear because nothing can separate us from God's love.
