“Jesus Is Making All Things New”

HIS KINGDOM COME - PT 20

Revelation 20:11-15, Revelation 21:1-8, Philippians 1:6

1. Jesus restores what sin has broken.
2. Jesus destroys death forever.
3. Jesus wipes away every tear.
4. Jesus renews people to be members of God's family.

Big Idea:

Jesus completes God's kingdom plan by destroying death and restoring creation so He can come to dwell among His people to rule with Him forever.

Connect and Engage:

- Take a few minutes for each person to share a recent high and low.

Read Revelation 20:11-15.

- When you imagine the day when there is no more death, pain, sorrow, or separation, what excites you most about life with Jesus? How does that hope encourage you in your life today?
- Jesus restores what sin has broken. During His earthly ministry, He healed the sick, gave sight to the blind, restored the broken, and even raised the dead. What do these reveal about Jesus' character, His heart for people, and His mission in the world?
- Jesus renews people and welcomes them into God's family. How have you experienced His renewing work in your life, and where is He continuing to transform you today?

Apply:

Jesus promises to satisfy those who thirst for Him and bless those who persevere in faith. Where do you sense the Holy Spirit inviting you to take a step of deeper trust, obedience, or perseverance this week? How can we pray for you?

Pray:

Read Philippians 1:6: *“And I am certain that God, who began the good work within you, will continue his work until it is finally finished on the day when Christ Jesus returns.”*
