**“God’s Warnings Are the Sound of Mercy”**

HIS KINGDOM COME - PT 5  
Pastor Matt Mylin — February 1, 2026

---

*Revelation 8:1-13, Hebrews 12:18-29*

The Lamb initiates God’s warning to people before His judgment escalates.

What these warnings reveal about Jesus:

1. He loves His people enough to disrupt what cannot save them.
2. He exposes false dependence.
3. He confronts counterfeit authority by revealing Himself.

Reflection:

Where is Jesus inviting you to a deeper trust in Him?

**CONNECT > ENGAGE > SERVE***Small Group Meeting Guide***Big Idea:**

The Lamb initiates God’s warning to lovingly disrupt false stability and invite His people to trust Him more deeply before judgment escalates.

**Connect and Engage:**

- Take a few minutes for each person to share a recent high and low.
- Read Revelation 8:1-13.
  - God’s warnings are described as “the sound of mercy.” How does that change the way you hear these passages, and the uncomfortable moments God uses to wake us up?
  - What are some warning signs God has used in your life to get your attention, and how do you usually respond when you notice them?
  - What are some practical ways you can shift your attention or trust, from something that promises control or stability, back to Jesus as your true source of life?

**Apply:**

Where is Jesus inviting you to a deeper trust in Him today? What is one step you can take this week to respond?

**Pray:**

Pray for one another, inviting the Holy Spirit to deepen our trust in Jesus and help us walk out what He’s calling us into.
