HIS KINGDOM COME - PT 21

Revelation 21:9-27, Revelation 21:7, Colossians 1:25-27, Ephesians 2:19-22

1. Jesus restores a people who belong to Him.
2. Jesus restores His people as members of God’s family.
3. Jesus restores His people as citizens of God’s kingdom.
4. Jesus restores His people to their original purpose.

Big Idea:

Jesus has come to dwell with His bride and restore His people to their intended purpose under His rule and reign.

Connect and Engage:

- Take a few minutes for each person to share a recent high and low.
- Read Revelation 21:9-10. The holy city is God’s redeemed people who belong to Him. How does knowing you belong to Jesus and represent a holy city give you confidence?
- Read Ephesians 2:20. Belonging to God in His house means you are built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Jesus being the Chief Cornerstone. How does knowing that others have laid a foundation for you to live from encourage you to shine for God in your family or workplace?
- Our salvation, for which Jesus gave His life, is restoring those who have repented and placed faith in Him. How has His restoration changed how you live your life recently?

Apply:

When you face life’s challenging moments (i.e., a diagnosis, a broken relationship, financial struggles, etc.), what have you observed about yourself? How will understanding that you belong to Jesus and His people help you to respond to your next (or current) challenge?

Pray:

Father God, we thank You that we belong to You. We also thank You that we are a holy city, a people set apart to bring glory to You here on earth. Grant us the power to live our lives for You and to bring Your truths to people You have placed in our lives. We ask these things in Jesus’ Name, amen.
