1. Jesus deserves all praise.

2. Jesus is returning for a prepared bride.
  - Pure white reflects a life made holy and set apart as exclusively His.
  - Fine linen reflects a life of faithful obedience.
3. Jesus is revealing Himself so we will remain faithful.

### Small Group Meeting Guide

---

#### Big Idea:

Jesus is returning for a faithful bride, so it is time for the Church to prepare for His return.

#### Connect and Engage:

- Take a few minutes for each person to share a recent high and low.
- Read Revelation 19:1-10. This passage helps us understand three aspects of Jesus and how we should prepare for His return; one of these three aspects is preparation. How are you preparing for Jesus' return? Since your preparation reflects your priorities, what are your priorities reflecting?
- Read James 1:12. God blesses those who patiently endure testing and temptation. Afterward, they will receive the crown of life that God has promised to those who love Him. How you live on earth matters. Faithfulness and obedience are tests. Share an experience you have had with obedience and or faithfulness.
- Read Ephesians 2:8-10. Good works do not earn salvation, but they reveal a life that belongs to Jesus. What is God calling you to do in this season of your life?

#### Apply:

Jesus said if you are faithful with little, you will be faithful with much. What have you been entrusted with?

#### Pray:

Spend time praying for clear direction, clear priorities, and faithfulness with the treasures that God has given to us.
