Happy 250th Birthday to the USA from the Church Library! Check out the following books in the library in room E100:

Signing Their Lives Away: The Fame and Misfortune of the Men Who Signed the Declaration of Independence by Denise Kierman and Joseph D'Agnese. In 1776, 56 men risked their lives and fortunes to defy King George III by signing the Declaration of Independence. Here are short profiles of each individual who signed.

American Heroes: Profiles of the men and women who shaped early America by Edward S. Morgan and Thomas Jefferson by Joanna Johnston. Jefferson wrote his own epitaph in which he did not mention his time as President. Instead, he wanted to be remembered as crafting two major documents as well as the founding of the University of Virginia.
