Dr. T. Scott Daniels
General Superintendent

Dr. T. Scott Daniels was elected as the 44th general superintendent in the Church of the Nazarene at the 30th General Assembly, in June 2023. At the time of his election, he was serving as senior pastor at Nampa College Church of the Nazarene in Nampa, Idaho.

Scott was ordained in 1992. Throughout his ministry he has bridged the gap between the church and the academy. He has served in many roles of local church ministry, including twenty-one years as lead pastor for three different congregations. Scott also served on theology faculties at Southern Nazarene and Northwest Nazarene Universities and served as the Dean of the School of Theology and Seminary at Azusa Pacific University.

Dr. Daniels received a Bachelor of Arts degree from Northwest Nazarene University in 1988 and a Master of Divinity degree from Fuller Theological Seminary in 1992. He earned a PhD in Theology and Ethics from Fuller Theological Seminary in 2000. And he just recently received an honorary Doctor of Divinity degree from his alma mater, NNU.

Scott loves teaching, preaching, and writing. He has been married to his wife and partner in ministry, Debbie, for 36 years. Debbie has a passion for helping ministry spouses love and embrace the ministry that God has given to them. They still live in Nampa, Idaho. Their four adult children (Caleb, Noah, Jonah, and Sophia) and their spouses, and their new grandbaby, also live near them in Idaho.

Mark grew up in Anaheim, CA and attended Anaheim First Church of the Nazarene with his family. Following graduation from high school, he attended Point Loma Nazarene University and graduated with a B.A. in Biblical Literature. He completed a M.A in Theology from PLNU and served as youth pastor at his home church in Anaheim before attending Nazarene Theological Seminary (NTS) in Kansas City, MO. While a student at NTS, Mark met his wife, Debi, in Sunday school at Kansas City First Church of the Nazarene. They were married on June 25, 1988 in Debi's hometown of Mount Vernon, OH. After graduation from NTS with a Master of Divinity, Mark and Debi moved to Washington state to begin their ministry assignment as youth pastor for the Grandview Church of the Nazarene.

Mark was called to be the senior pastor at the Sutter Creek Church of the Nazarene in June 1995. As pastor in Sutter Creek, Mark served in various ministry and leadership roles in the church and community as well as completing a Doctor of Ministry degree from Azusa Pacific University. After 25 years at Sutter Creek, Mark was appointed to be the District Superintendent for the Southwest Oklahoma District in June 2020 and served there until his election as District Superintendent for the Los Angeles District in 2023.

Mark and Debi are blessed to have three daughters and one son-in-law: Erin, Emily and her husband Evan Walsh, and Abby. They are especially excited about their granddaughters Eliana Carolyn Walsh and Talia Claire Walsh who have brought a new level of joy to their lives. The Committee offers financial guidance and support to District auxiliaries and local churches, oversees and advises regarding properties owned or operated within the District, and seeks to support the ministries of the Church and District through responsible stewardship and sound fiscal leadership.

The responsibilities of the Finance Committee and Properties Board are to:

1. Encourage full participation of all District churches in “Funding the Mission.”
2. Prepare, oversee, and manage District investments and the operating budget.
3. Work with all District auxiliaries and the District Treasurer to provide for and execute the annual CPA audit or financial review.
4. Oversee and provide guidance regarding District-owned properties and property-related matters as needed.
5. Support the ministries of the Church and District through responsible stewardship, financial accountability, and sound fiscal leadership.

During the past year, the Finance Committee and Properties Board:

1. Created an Endowment fund to be used for church plants and investments.
2. Completed an in-depth CPA review of all District financial activity.
3. Reviewed and revamped the District financial reporting process to improve clarity, accountability, and transparency.
4. Established an investment relationship with Van Hulzen Investment Management.
5. Surveyed all church properties within the District to identify deferred maintenance needs and future property concerns.
6. Moved the District Office to smaller and affordable premises.
7. Managed the sale of the District Office building.
8. Moved the Atascadero property into direct District management.

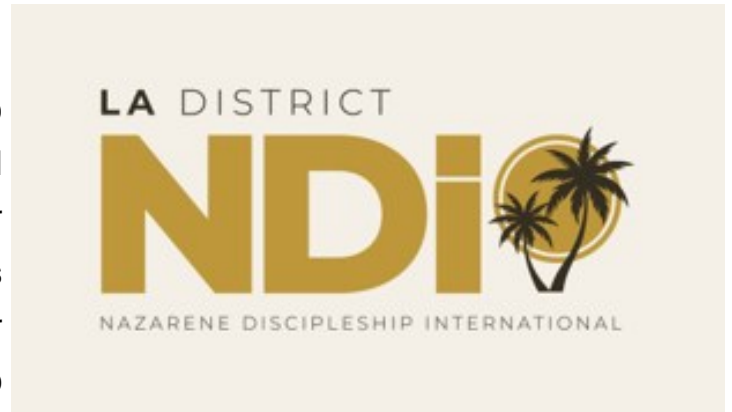
