During our stay, MBCC will have access to the entire property. We will have lodging options at both the retreat center, and the camp cabins (See below). Indoor meeting space and ample outdoor space will provide a perfect setting for exploring and growing our faith as a church community. The site features a paved labyrinth, fire pit, fields, sport courts, and of course guided activities like visiting the farm, and archery with the friendly and super fun LRCC staff.

Outside of meals, programming, and the service project, our time at camp is designed for you to choose your own path & join where you find meaning.


