- Demolition tearing out walls, old cabinets, flooring, etc.
- Putting up walls & ceilings
- Filling potholes
- Pouring concrete
- Visiting & praying for our widows & senior residents
- Sorting clothes and/or helping customers in our clothing closet
- Helping in our after school program / summer reading program
- Help put on a Community BBQ or do a VBS

Things to Consider:

- Trips can be physically demanding
- The temperatures in the summer can be very hot and/or humid
- Bunk beds

Extending Ministry:

One of the ways your group can help to extend the ministry of Community Servants is to provide the following much needed supplies. Trip participants are encouraged to ask friends and family to help donate the following items:

Each Team Member to Bring:

- One 3" Paint Brush
- One pkg of Paint Roller Covers OR One pkg of Paint Pan Liners (they usually come in sets of 3)
- One pkg of Boys, Girls, Mens, or Womens Underwear
- One pkg of Boys, Girls, Mens, or Womens Socks
- One pack of Diapers, any size
- One Kids Lunch Box **OR** One Kids Backpack
