

Concerning the Lord's Supper



We celebrate the Lord's Supper believing that this sacred meal is Christ's gift to His Church. Paul encourages us to examine ourselves before we *"eat of the bread and drink of the cup. For those who eat and drink without discerning the body of Christ eat and drink judgment on themselves"* (1 Corinthians 11:28-29). We request that those who wish to commune here answer yes to the following questions:

- *Do you believe that you are a sinner and in need of forgiveness from God?*
- *Do you believe that forgiveness is found only in Christ and is offered by Christ in the Lord's Supper?*
- *Do you believe that Christ's body and blood are truly present in, with, and under the bread and wine?*
- *Do you believe in Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior, and by your participation in the sacrament, give testimony to the faith we share?*
- *Do you desire by the power of the Holy Spirit according to God's Word to live a life pleasing to Him?*

If you have questions regarding this, please speak with one of the pastors. Non-communing adults and children can come forward to receive a blessing by folding their hands across their chest or you are welcome to remain seated as we celebrate the Lord's Supper.
